Since the year 2000 Prof. Dr. **Peter De Mey** teaches at the Catholic university of Leuven, Belgium, where he holds the chair of ecclesiology and ecumenism.

More than 30 doctoral dissertations have successfully been defended under his guidance.

His research focuses on the development of ecumenism prior to Vatican II, the redaction history and interpretation of *Lumen Gentium*, *Unitatis Redintegratio* and *Orientalium Ecclesiarum*, post-conciliar Roman Catholic ecclesiology and the bilateral and multilateral ecumenical dialogues.

Since 2010 the episcopal conference of Belgium has given him the mandate of president of the Board of the National Commission for Ecumenism.
